

Duration

4 months - approx. 2 hours per week of study using an online learning platform.

Who is the Therapeutic Parenting Programme for?

The SAfE Parenting Programme is aimed at parents looking after children who have experienced early life trauma, parents caring for a neurodivergent child and families who are accessing edge-of-care services. The qualification can be useful for parents embarking on the graduated pathway for an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP).

Qualification Content

The programme includes 4 units which include:

- Providing parents with underpinning knowledge of Therapeutic Parenting strategies.
- Knowledge of how to build the foundations of a trusting relationship.
- Understanding how to meet the needs of the growing and developing child.
- Parental compassion fatigue - Looking after ourselves.

Mode of Learning

Learners have support from a programme tutor and peer support for their studies through an online forum.

Please note: The qualifications are predominantly studied online through a learning platform; therefore, it is a prerequisite for applicants to be ICT/computer literate.



Qualification Benefits

Not only will parents be able to learn and put into practice Therapeutic Parenting strategies, which will help them to develop a trusting relationship with their child, but they will also gain certification of our CACHE Accredited Customised Qualification in SAfE Parenting.

Certification

This qualification is certified by The Centre of Excellence in Child Trauma (CoECT). Once completed, learners will receive a certificate from The Centre of Excellence in Child Trauma.
